- That our upcoming Street Preachers' Charter will help the Gospel to spread.

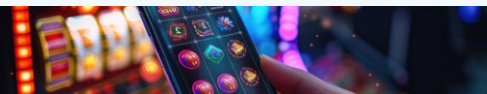
Wednesday
